Stethoscope – El estetoscopio

(el es-tay-toh-SCOH-peehoh)

Bag – La bolsa (la BOL-sah)

Bandage/Bandaid – La curita, la tiritas
(la koo-REE-tah, la tee-REE-tah)

Thermometer – El termómetro

(el tehr-MOH-may-troh)

Needle – La aguja (la ah-GOO-ha)

Shot – La inyección (la een-yek-seeOHN)

Reflex hammer – El martillo de reflejo
(el mar-TEE-yo day ray-FLAY-hoh)

X-ray – El rayo X, la radiografía
(el rayo ec-ees, la rah-deeoh-grah-FEE-ah)

How do you feel? – ¿Cómo te sientes?
(KOH-mo tay seeEN-tays)

I feel well/good – Me siento bien
(may seeEN-toh beeEN)

I feel bad/I don't feel well – Me siento mal
(may seeEN-toh mahl)

My head hurts – Me duele la cabeza
(may DWAY-lay la kah-BAY-sah)

I have a fever – Tengo fiebre
(TAN-goh fee-A-bray)

I have a cold – Estoy resfriado/a (es-TOY
res-free-AH-doh/dah) [note: there are several
ways to say this phrase]

Medicine – La medicina

(la may-dee-SEE-nah)

Tissue/Kleenex – El pañuelo de papel
(el pah-NYWAY-loh day PAH-pel)

Get well soon – Mejórate pronto
(may-HOH-rah-tay PROHN-toh)

I'm sick – Estoy enfermo/a
(es-TOY en-FAIR-moh/mah)

Doctor – El/la médico/a, el/la doctor(a)
(el/la MAY-dee-koh/kah, dohk-TOR)

Nurse – El/la enfermero/a
(el/la en-fay-MAY-roh/rah)

Medical chart – El expediente médico
(may seeEN-toh beeEN)

Book – El libro (el LEE-bro)

Lab coat – La bata de laboratorio
(la BAH-tah day lah-boh-rah-TOH-reeoh)

Scrubs – El uniforme, el pijama sanitario
(el oo-nee-FOR-may,

el pee-HA-mah sah-nee-TAH-reeio)

Surgical glove – El guante quirúrgico
(el GWAN-tay kee-ROOR-hee-koh)

Prescription – La receta (la ray-SAY-tah)
